	Students who withdraw from the university and wish to be readmitted will be required to reapply through CASPA and successfully complete all admission criteria for the CASPA cycle. Students interested in re-admission after a withdrawal from the university will be treated the same as any other candidate applying to the DPAS. The potential readmission will be dependent on existing DPAS and university admissions criteria. Students are not automatically readmitted to the DPAS following a withdrawal from the university. Students who are readmitted to the DPAS after withdrawing from the university will be required to start the Program of Study over and will enter the program in the summer didactic semester.
