POSITION SUMMARY

The Special Education Teacher collaborates with the Autism Support Initiative Program Director/Clinical Supervisor and district administration to lead a team of Graduate Assistant Instructional Technicians in the provision of evidence-based special education services contracted with a Local Educational Agency (LEA).

This position follows the host school-district's schedule and hours of operation (approximately late August through early June). It includes a 100% tuition waiver and a stipend of \$25,000. The position also includes fieldwork supervision that satisfactorily meets the requirements of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Serves as the leader of the students and staff in their respective classroom.
- Providing evidence-based instruction, behavioral supports, and progress monitoring for student.
- Responsible for the moment-to-moment welfare, safety, and education of the students in the classroom.
- Develop and maintain the classroom's schedule.
- Submission of weekly lesson plans and providing curricular programming changes and supports to all students in a timely manner using data informed decisions.
- IEP development and implementation.
- Delegation of staff resources within the classroom.
- Consults with the clinical supervisor during regularly scheduled meetings or whenever necessary.

- Required: Holds active Instructional I or II Special Education PreK-12 in Pennsylvania
- Required: CPR & First Aid Certified (can be obtained by Recreation Center) with completion of clearances required by PDE/district
- Preferred: Enrolled in Applied Behavior Analysis concentration
- Preferred: Acceptance of a two-year graduate assistantship
