POSITION SUMMARY

The Special Education Instructional Technician collaborates with the Autism Support Initiative Program Director/Clinical Supervisor, Graduate Assistant Special Education Teacher, and other Graduate Assistant Instructional Technicians in the provision of evidence-based special education services contracted with a Local Educational Agency (LEA).

COMPENSATION

This position follows the host school-district's schedule and hours of operation (approximately late August through early June). It includes a 75% tuition waiver and a stipend of \$12,000. The position also includes fieldwork supervision that satisfactorily meets the requirements of the Behavior Analyst Certification Board (BACB).

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides skill instruction to all students and assists with curricular programming/development.
- Collects, graphs, and analyzes student behavioral and academic data.
- Assists with meeting children's personal and healthcare needs, as necessary.
- Assisting the special education teacher with materials preparation and the ongoing operation of the classroom.

- Preferred: Active Instructional I or II Special Education PreK-12 in Pennsylvania.
